4. **Tell** others every day about Jesus and His wonderful gift of eternal salvation, Acts 2:47.

1 Know how to pray so we know for sure God is listening.

*"We know that God **heareth** not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and **doeth his will**, him he **heareth**."* –John 9:31

First thing, **God's will** is that you be saved from the penalty and power of sin. **"God our Saviour . . . will** (wills to; wants to) **have all men to be saved**, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth."*–1 Timothy 2:3–4* "The Lord is . . . not willing that any should perish, but that **all** should **come** to repentance."*–2 Peter 3:9*

Then, *"If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall **ask** what ye will, and **it shall be done** unto you."* –John 15:7.

Simply listen to God, and God will listen to you.

2 Put ourselves in "protective custody" of the one and only Almighty God.

*"He that dwelleth in the **secret place** of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the **Almighty**. I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and **my fortress**: my God; in him will I trust."* –Psalm 91:1–2

3 Get prepared to meet God on judgment day in case today is our last day on earth.

*"It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the **judgment**."* –Hebrews 9:27.

But because *"God commendeth [showed] his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us**."* –Romans 5:8

*"There is therefore now **no condemnation** to them which are in Christ Jesus."* –Romans 8:1.

*"For I delivered unto you **first of all** that which I also received, how that Christ **died for our sins** according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that **he rose again** the third day according to the scriptures."* –1 Corinthians 15: 1–4

*"For the wages of sin is **death**; but the gift of God is **eternal life** through Jesus Christ our Lord."* –Romans 6:23.

*"For whosoever **shall call** upon the name of the Lord **shall be saved**."* –Romans 10:13

4 Understand God's plan for us here and now on earth and follow His leadership.
